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## Curriculum vitae

Harald Tauber studied at the Conservatory Wr. Neustadt vocal pedagogy and "Musical, Operetta, Chanson" at the Vienna Conservatory with honours. During his studies, he took on leading roles in JESUS CHRIST SUPERSTAR, INTO THE WOODS, THE ROCKY HORROR SHOW, Mozart's BASTIEN & BASTIENNE and Goethe's DIE MITSCHULDIGEN. Afterwards, he went to the Vereinigten Bühnen Vienna for the world premiere of TANZ DER VAMPIRE, where he also performed in MOZART! and JEKYLL & HYDE. For the German premiere of WE WILL ROCK YOU, he moved to Cologne in 2005 and worked with Brian May and Roger Taylor of Queen. In 2008/09 he created the roles Ofir and Kolo Moser at the world premieres of TUTANCHAMUN and GUSTAV KLIMT in Gutenstein. In 2012 he was seen in Tecklenburg as Duke of Buckingham in 3 MUSKETEERS. He organized galas for the benefit of Austrian Cancer Aid, produced the CDs "Freiheit" and "Traumwelt", worked as a music teacher and in 2011 founded a theatre agency in Cologne. From 2012-14 he played in the musical SISTER ACT, first in Stuttgart and then in Oberhausen the Monsignore and Curtis Jackson. In 2015 he produced his rock comedy HIMMLISCH GEROCKT! and the CD "Step By Step" with his rock band Mates in Rock. In 2016/17 he played at Festspielhaus Füssen Graf Rettenberg in LUDWIG<sup>2</sup> and produced the CD "Still Play Rock'n'Roll". In 2017-19 numerous concerts and engagements followed in the tic Kassel.
